Re: Homestretch Campaign for Completion of the Conover-Phelps bike trail

We're excited as Phelps/Vilas County enthusiasts to update you on the status of the Conover-Phelps bike trail. Since 2015, 8.7 miles of the trail have been completed. The remaining leg of the trail is 1.9 miles from Song Hill Road to downtown Phelps at Pines Park. Federal, state and local governmental approvals are in place for this final construction.

To bring the trail into downtown Phelps, the Great Headwaters Trails organization has initiated the Homestretch campaign, with the goal of funding this last trail construction by this summer. Our fundraising goal is \$187,000.

As a 501(c)3 tax exempt organization, Great Headwaters Trails created the Yard and Mile Club to encourage supporters to contribute toward achievement of the 100% funding goal. Donations of any size are welcome and are tax deductible.
